



INTERACTIVE PARENTING SUPPORT LEVELS OF VISITATION

Interactive Parenting Support was formerly named "Supervised Visitation".

What are the levels of IPS visits at Riverside Family Support?

IN-ROOM SUPERVISED

RFS worker is present in the room for the duration of the visit to ensure all contact is positive and appropriate.

OUT OF ROOM SUPERVISED

RFS worker will start & end the visit but will not remain in the visit room. The children and visiting party will be supervised using RFS cameras. (Sight and sound supervision)

COMMUNITY VISIT SUPERVISED

Visits take place in the community. (Park, Mall, etc.) RFS worker will remain with the parent(s) and children at all times. RFS worker will transport the child(ren) if needed during the visit. Sight and partial sound (environment permitting) supervision.

COMMUNITY VISIT UNSUPERVISED

RFS worker will meet with the parent and child at the start and end of the visit and will pop in occasionally throughout (as needed).

If necessary, RFS & DSS workers can decide to move backward in the progression of visits.

IN-HOME VISITS

These visits will take place when the family is closer to a trial home placement.

An FPM may take place to prepare all parties for the schedule of visits and progression in duration.

Examples of in-home visits:

Full-day visit, Overnight Visit, or Weekend Visit
RFS worker will stop by the home unannounced at various times during the visit to ensure all visit expectations are met.
